

THE TOWN OF CARMAN  
BY-LAW NO. 68/105

A by-law of The Town of Carman to rescind By-Law No. 67/1049, a by-law to authorize the cancellation of local improvement taxes levied against Crown-owned lands within the said Town.

WHEREAS By-Law No. 67/1049, a by-law of The Town of Carman to cancel local improvement taxes levied against Crown-owned lands within The Town of Carman, was read a third time and passed on the twenty-eighth day of December, A.D. 1967, and submitted to the Municipal Board for authorization;

AND WHEREAS it has since been determined by officers of the Department of Urban Development and Municipal Affairs that the by-law is not necessary, as grants in amounts equal to the taxes to be cancelled have been received from the Crown by The Town of Carman in lieu of the taxes to be cancelled and that the removal of the said taxes from the roll constitutes an adjustment rather than a cancellation;

THEREFORE the council of The Town of Carman enacts as follows:

1. THAT By-Law No. 67/1049 of The Town of Carman be and hereby is rescinded.
