

THE TOWN OF CARMAN
BY-LAW NO. 68/1075

Being a by-law of The Town of Carman for opening a street and widening a lane, pursuant to section 474 of The Municipal Act.

WHEREAS section 474 of The Municipal Act provides, in part, as follows:

- (1) Every municipal corporation may pass by-laws
 - (a) for opening, establishing, making, preserving, maintaining, improving, constructing, repairing, widening, enlarging, altering, diverting, or closing highways within its jurisdiction, and for entering upon, breaking up, taking, or using, any land in any way necessary or convenient for the purposes, subject to the restrictions in this Act, and for preventing and removing any obstruction upon any such highways;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that a street be opened, and a lane be widened over, upon and across the lands hereinafter described

NOW THEREFORE BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY PASSED AND ENACTED AS A BY-LAW OF THE TOWN OF CARMAN, IN COUNCIL DULY ASSEMBLED, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That a street be and is hereby opened and established, and a public lane be and is hereby widened over, upon and across the lands described as follows:

All those portions of Lots 14 to 21, in Block 24, as shown in a plan of survey registered in the Carman Land Titles Office as No. 32, as shown bordered red on a plan of survey of the said Lots and Block prepared by Allan Calder Findlay, of the City of Winnipeg, in Manitoba, Manitoba Land Surveyor, and duly attested by him on the seventeenth day of October, A.D. 1968;

and the said lands are hereby dedicated to the public for that purpose.

2. That the said plan of survey is hereby adopted and approved, and that the Secretary-Treasurer is authorized and directed to endorse the aforementioned plan of survey for identification, placing thereon his signature, under the corporate seal of the Municipality, together with a reference to this by-law.



and the said lands are hereby dedicated to the public for that purpose.




