

THE TOWN OF CARMAN
BY-LAW NO. 69/1083

A by-law of The Town of Carman to appoint a secretary-treasurer of the said Town and to set out his duties and rate of remuneration.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of section 345 of The Municipal Act, being Chapter 173 of the Revised Statutes of Manitoba, 1954, and amendments thereto, every municipal corporation shall, by by-law, appoint a clerk;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of section 349 of the said Municipal Act, every municipal corporation shall, by by-law, appoint a treasurer;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of section 351(1) of the said Municipal Act, the offices of clerk and treasurer may both be held by the same person, who shall in such case be called the secretary-treasurer;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of sections 345 and 349 of the said Municipal Act, the clerk and treasurer may be paid an annual salary;

NOW THEREFORE, the council of The Town of Carman, in regular council assembled, enacts as follows:

1. THAT Abram Lincoln Loepky, of The Town of Carman, be and hereby is appointed to the office of Secretary-Treasurer of The Town of Carman.
2. THAT the duties of the said Secretary-Treasurer shall be such as are defined by statute or as may be assigned to him by by-law or resolution of The Town of Carman.
3. THAT the said Secretary-Treasurer shall be paid an annual salary of seven thousand, two hundred dollars (\$7,200.00), payable monthly.
4. THAT the said Secretary-Treasurer shall be paid an annual allowance of three hundred dollars (\$300.00), payable monthly, as consideration for the use of his automobile on the business of the corporation within the limits of the corporation.
5. THAT the said Secretary-Treasurer shall be entitled to such fees for tax certificates as are or may be allowed him pursuant to the provisions of section 1191 of The Municipal Act and for vital statistics as are or may be allowed him pursuant to the provisions of section 29(2) of The Vital Statistics Act.
6. THAT this by-law shall be retroactive to the first day of January, A.D. 1969.
