

THE TOWN OF CARMAN
BY-LAW NO. 71/1120

A by-law of The Town of Carman to provide for and authorize the remuneration of, and payment of certain expenses to, members of the council of The Town of Carman in the year A.D. 1971.

WHEREAS The Municipal Act, S. M. 1970, c. 100 - Cap. M225, Part III, Division II, Subdivision VI, provides for the remuneration of, and the payment of certain expenses to, members of the council of a municipality, if a by-law of the municipality so provides;


AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and in the best interests of The Town of Carman, by by-law, to provide for the payment of monthly indemnities, daily indemnities, and certain expenses to the mayor and each councillor of The Town of Carman in the year A.D. 1971;

NOW THEREFORE the council of The Town of Carman, in regular council assembled, enacts as follows:

1. THAT, pursuant to the provisions of section 109 of The Municipal Act,
 - (a) the mayor shall be paid a monthly indemnity of one hundred and twenty-five dollars (\$125.00); and
 - (b) each councillor shall be paid a monthly indemnity of eighty-three dollars and thirty-three and one-third cents (\$83.33 1/3).
2. THAT, pursuant to the provisions of subsection (1) of section 111 of The Municipal Act, each member of the council, if duly authorized, by resolution of the council, specifying the purpose of the journey, to go on a special journey beyond the limits of the corporation on the business thereof, shall be paid
 - (a) his actual travelling expenses, and his actual living expenses; and
 - (b) an indemnity of twenty dollars (\$20.00) for each day he is actually engaged in that business.
3. THAT, pursuant to the provisions of subsection (4) of section 111 of The Municipal Act, all members of the council, if duly authorized by a resolution of the council, to attend a meeting of
 - (a) Manitoba Urban Association; or
 - (b) Union of Manitoba Municipalities; or
 - (c) The Canadian Federation of Mayors and Municipalities; or
 - (d) such other organization that in the opinion of the council it is in the interests of the municipality to belong;shall be paid
 - (e) the actual travelling expenses and the actual living expenses; and
 - (f) an indemnity of twenty dollars (\$20.00) for each day he is actually engaged in travelling to, attendance at, and returning from any such meeting.
4. THAT the words "actual travelling expenses," when they apply to a member of the council travelling in a private motor car owned by him or operated at his expense, shall be deemed to mean twelve cents (12¢) per mile, each way, from his place of residence in The Town of Carman to the place or places at which the business was conducted or the meeting attended.
5. THAT the monthly indemnities to which reference is made in clause 1 be paid monthly, or at such less frequent intervals as may be indicated by each individual member of the council.
6. THAT the indemnities and expenses to which reference is made in clauses 2, 3 and 4 shall be paid each month subsequent to the submission thereof to the committee on finance.
7. THAT this by-law shall be retroactive to the first day of January, A.D. 1971.
