THE TOWN OF CARMAN  
BY-LAW NO. 71/1122 ✓

A by-law of The Town of Carman to amend By-Law No. 902, being a by-law of the said Town to provide for the regulation of traffic in the said Town.

WHEREAS The Highway Traffic Act, S. M. 1966, c. 29 - Cap. H60, section 86, subsection (1), provides, partly, as follows:

"Each traffic authority may classify vehicles according to dimensions, design, use, weight, kind of load carried, or otherwise; and for any class or all classes may make rules supplementary to, or in addition to, but not contrary to, any other provision of this Act, and applicable on highways over which the traffic authority has jurisdiction, with respect to

(a) parking, stopping, standing, of vehicles; and may impose penalties for a violation of such rule.";

AND WHEREAS the council of The Town of Carman deems it in the interest of the said Town to restrict the parking of certain motor vehicles on the streets over which the said council has jurisdiction;

THEREFORE the council of The Town of Carman, in regular council assembled, enacts as follows:


1. By-Law No. 902 of The Town of Carman is amended by adding thereto, immediately after clause 9 thereof, the following clause:

9A. No person shall park any motor vehicle whose gross vehicle weight exceeds 5,000 pounds on any street over which the council of The Town of Carman has jurisdiction for a period of time longer than two hours.
