

THE TOWN OF CARMAN  
BY-LAW NO. 72/1138 ✓

A by-law of The Town of Carman providing for the cancellation of certain taxes owing to the said Town.

WHEREAS The Municipal Act, S.M. 1970, c. 100 - Cap. M224, section 885, provides as follows:

"885(1) Subject to section 655, the council of a municipality, by by-law, may cancel in whole or in part any taxes or any debt or moneys owing to the municipality.


885(2) No by-law passed under this section has any force or effect until the minister certifies that evidence has been filed with him establishing the bona fides of the by-law, and that it is in the best interest of the municipality.";

AND WHEREAS it is deemed in the best interest of the municipality that certain taxes owing to The Town of Carman be cancelled;

NOW THEREFORE the council of The Town of Carman, in council duly assembled, enacts as follows:

1. THAT three real property taxes and business taxes, as set forth in Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of this by-law, be and are hereby cancelled.
2. THAT this by-law has full force and effect on and from the day on which the minister certifies that evidence has been filed with him establishing the bona fides of the by-law, and that it is in the best interest of The Town of Carman.


