

THE TOWN OF CARMAN
BY-LAW NO. 72/1154 ✓ R.P.

A by-law of The Town of Carman to authorize the purchase of certain lands from Earl Henry Johnston, of The Town of Carman, labourer, for the purpose of widening a public lane.

WHEREAS The Municipal Act, S. M. 1970, c. 100 - M225, Part IV, Division I, section 197, subsection (1), provides as follows:

- "197(1) A municipality may acquire
- (a) any real or personal property that the council thereof deems
 - (i) to be necessary for the purposes of the municipality; or
 - (ii) will facilitate the exercise of the powers of the municipality or the discharge of the duties thereof; and
 - (b) any interest in any such property."

AND WHEREAS the council of The Town of Carman deems it expedient and in the best interest of the municipality to acquire the land hereinafter described for the purposes of widening a public lane;

AND WHEREAS the council of The Town of Carman has negotiated the purchase of the land hereinafter described from Earl Henry Johnston, of The Town of Carman, labourer, in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00);

NOW THEREFORE the council of The Town of Carman, in regular council assembled, enacts as follows:


1. THAT the land legally described as:

In The Town of Carman, in the Province of Manitoba, and being the most easterly fifteen (15) feet in depth of all except the most northerly twenty (20) feet of Lot 47 and Lots 48 and 49, all in Block 3, which lots and block are shewn on a Plan of Survey of part of The Town of Carman, in the Province of Manitoba, registered in the Morden Land Titles Office (Carman Division) as No. 64-C

be purchased from Earl Henry Johnston, of The Town of Carman, labourer, in consideration of the payment of the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) by The Town of Carman to Earl Henry Johnston.


2. THAT the proper officers of The Town of Carman are hereby authorized to execute all documents and take all steps necessary to complete the purchase of the above described land and to convey title of same into the name of the said The Town of Carman.
