

THE TOWN OF CARMAN
BY-LAW NO. 73/1183

A by-law of The Town of Carman to appoint a secretary-treasurer of the said Town and to set out his duties and rate of remuneration.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of The Municipal Act, being chapter 100 - Cap. M225 of The Statutes of Manitoba, every municipality shall, by by-law, appoint a clerk;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of section 147 of the said Municipal Act, every municipal council shall, by by-law, appoint a treasurer of the municipality;


AND WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of section 154(1) of the said Municipal Act, the offices of clerk and treasurer may both be held by the same person, who shall in such case be called the secretary-treasurer and he shall perform and exercise the duties and powers of clerk and treasurer;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of section 154(2) of the said Municipal Act, every municipality may, by by-law, appoint a secretary-treasurer;

NOW THEREFORE the council of The Town of Carman, in regular council assembled, enacts as follows:

1. THAT Abram Lincoln Loepky, of The Town of Carman, be and hereby is appointed to the office of Secretary-Treasurer of The Town of Carman.
2. THAT the duties of the secretary-treasurer shall be as set forth in The Municipal Act, section 143(2) and section 148(1).
3. THAT the said secretary-treasurer shall be paid an annual salary of ten thousand, five hundred dollars, including an allowance of six hundred dollars for the use of his automobile on the business of the Town of Carman within the limits of the Town.
4. THAT the annual emolument set forth in section 3 shall be paid on a bi-weekly basis.
5. THAT the said secretary-treasurer shall be entitled to such fees for tax certificates as are set forth in section 880 of The Municipal Act and for vital statistics as are set forth in section 29 of The Vital Statistics Act.
6. THAT this by-law shall be retroactive to the first day of January, A.D. 1973.
