

BEING a By-law of the Town of Carman for opening a highway pursuant to Section 209 of The Municipal Act.

WHEREAS Section 209 of The Municipal Act provides, in part, as follows:

- (1) Subject to Subsections (2), (3) and (4), the Council of a Municipality may pass by-laws;
 - a) for opening, establishing, making, preserving, maintaining, improving, constructing, repairing, widening, or enlarging, any highway;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that a highway be opened over, upon and across the lands hereinafter described.

NOW THEREFORE be it and it is hereby passed and enacted as a By-Law of the Town of Carman, in council duly assembled, as follows:


- 1) THAT a highway be and is hereby opened and established over, upon, and across the lands described as follows:

All that portion of the South-East Quarter of Section Twenty-five (25), in Township Six (6) and Range Five (5), West of the Principal Meridian, in Manitoba, being part of Plan No. 758, registered in the Morden Land Titles Office (Carman Division) shown colored Pink on a Plan of Survey made by George R. Kilgour, a Manitoba Land Surveyor, on the 30th day of October, A.D. 1975, on the 19th day of November, A.D. 1976 and sworn to by him on the 24th day of November, A.D. 1976.


and the said lands are hereby dedicated to the public for that purpose.

- 2) THAT the said Plan of Survey is hereby adopted and approved, and the Secretary-Treasurer is authorized and directed to endorse the aforementioned plan of survey for identification, placing thereon his signature, under the corporate seal of the Municipality, together with a reference to this By-Law.
