

THE TOWN OF CARMAN

BY-LAW NO. 79/1405 ✓

A by-law of the Town of Carman to authorize the Town of Carman to enter into an Agreement with the Province of Manitoba Department of Highways to install, construct and maintain a sewer and water line across Provincial Trunk Highway No. 3, from the west side of Main Street S. to service Lot 20, Plan 1358.

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Carman deems it expedient and in the best interests of the Town, to extend, construct and maintain sewer and water lines from the west side of Main Street South, east across Provincial Trunk Highway No. 3, to service Lot 20, Plan 1358, in the said Town, and

WHEREAS an Agreement has been prepared by the Province of Manitoba, permitting the Town to construct and maintain a sewer and water line upon and under a portion of Provincial Trunk Highway No. 3, which agreement is attached as Appendix "A" to this By-law, and

WHEREAS by virtue of the said Agreement, the Town of Carman undertakes certain responsibilities as set out in the said Agreement, and


WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Carman deems it expedient and in the best interest of the said Town to enter the said Agreement including all undertakings therein, now

THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Carman, in Council assembled, hereby enact as follows:

1. THAT the Town of Carman enter into an Agreement with the Province of Manitoba, Department of Highways, a copy of which Agreement is attached hereto as Appendix "A";
2. THAT the Council of the Town of Carman hereby direct and authorize the Mayor and Secretary-Treasurer to execute the said Agreement on behalf of the Town of Carman.
