

THE TOWN OF CARMAN

BY-LAW # 89/1634

Being a By-Law of The Town of Carman, for closing a portion of Highways, pursuant to Section 215 of The Municipal Act.

WHEREAS Section 215 of The Municipal Act provides, in part, as follows:

(1) Subject to subsection (2), (3), and (4), the Council of a Municipality may pass by-laws:

(a) for closing any highway;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient that certain portions of highways described herein be closed.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY PASSED AND ENACTED IN COUNCIL DULY ASSEMBLED, AS FOLLOWS:

(1) THAT all those portions of the Public Highway described as follows:

All that portion of public lane in Block 7, Plan No. 64 MLTO (Carman Division) lying to the South of the straight production Easterly of the North limit of Lot 40 of said Block and Plan, which lies to the North of the straight production Easterly of the North limit of the Southerly 20 feet of Lot 46 of said Block and Plan.

SHALL be and same is hereby closed.


(2) THAT the title to all those portions of Public Highways so closed shall vest in the Town of Carman excepting thereout all mines and minerals.

(3) THAT the proper officers of the Town of Carman are hereby authorized and directed to do all acts and execute all documents required to give effect to this By-Law.
