

THE TOWN OF CARMAN

BY-LAW NO. 91/1667

---

BEING a by-law of the Town of Carman to provide for the exemption of levies for municipal purposes, for recreational facilities.

WHEREAS Section 2(8) of the Municipal Assessment Act, CM226, authorizes the Council of a Municipality to exempt from taxation, levies by Council for municipal purposes, and

WHEREAS the Town of Carman and the Rural Municipality of Dufferin are providing a recreational facility for use by the general public, and

WHEREAS the Council of the Town of Carman are of the opinion the Carman Arena should be exempt from taxation for municipal purposes, now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Carman, do hereby, exempt the Town of Carman and Rural Municipality of Dufferin building, housing the Carman Arena from taxation for municipal purposes on their building at 70 Kings Park Road, Carman, which is a recreational facilities for use by the general public.
