

THE TOWN OF CARMAN

BY-LAW NO. 94/1740

A By-law of the Town of Carman for opening a highway, pursuant to Section 215 of The Municipal Act.

WHEREAS Section 215 of The Municipal Act provides, in part, as follows:

- "(1) Subject to subsections (2), (3) and (4), the Council of a municipality may pass by-laws
 - (a) for opening, establishing, making, preserving, maintaining, improving, constructing, repairing, widening, or enlarging, any highway;"

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that a highway be opened over, upon and across the lands hereinafter described;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Town of Carman, in open session assembled, enacts as follows:

1. THAT a highway be and is hereby opened and established over, upon, and across the lands described as follows:

All that portion of the public highway shown on a plan prepared by Andre Van de Walle, Manitoba Land Surveyor, on the _____ day of _____, 1994, and sworn to him on the _____ day of _____, 1994.

and the said lands are hereby dedicated to the public for that purpose.

2. THAT the said plan of survey is hereby adopted and approved, and the secretary-treasurer is authorized and directed to endorse the aforementioned plan of survey for identification, placing thereon her signature, under the corporate seal of the municipality, together with a reference to this by-law.

3. THAT this by-law shall be valid and in effect on, from and after the day it received the approval of the Minister, by written order.
