Gentlemen: We your Committee beg to report
that we advise that all regular employees except
the Secretary Treasurer and Chief of Police be instructed
to each day keep a written record of labor performed
time of commencing time of finishing and time required
and actually spent in performing each particular
item of work.

That time of extra employees shall be kept by employee
under whom such labor is performed.

That a time book be furnished for each of the
regular employees.

That time books be submitted to Clerk weekly
for recording and that Clerk shall keep full and
intelligent records thereof.

Gentlemen: Your Committee appointed to examine and report as to weeds cut on Geo. Sussmith properties in Cannon by leave to report as follows. In Company with Mr Sussmith we examined all the properties owned by him as pointed out to us by Mr Sussmith and found on BEL 43 Lots 14 and 21 had some weeds cut which were still lying unburned. Blocks 46 and 48 did not appear to have had any weeds cut or the appearance of weeds having been cut and burned. We found some weeds had been cut and not burned on Lots 12 and 13 BEL 43. Lots are now owned by Mrs. Tuttle. We also found a lot of lumbering weed weeds standing uncut on street between Blocks 48 and 49. Between Hendersons & Mr. Ridge Houses. Your Committee recommend that the owners of Lots 14, 21, and 22 BEL 43. and Lots 12 and 13 BEL 43 be charged for cutting of weeds all of which is respectfully submitted
