

Pursuant to adjournment Council of Town of Carman met Friday Jan 24th at 8 o'clock P.M. Present Councillor Bridge McLoy Justice Sills and Councillor Bridge elected Chairman of the meeting.

The matter of draying of coal and wood was thoroughly discussed between all the licensed draymen of Carman and the Council present. After lengthy discussion prices satisfactory to the draymen and to all of the Council present were arrived at.

Councillor McLoy gave notice that at the next regular meeting of the Council he would introduce a Bylaw to amend bylaw no 134 by striking out the whole of ~~Class~~ paragraph three and inserting the following paragraph in lieu thereof.

"That the fees to be charged by draymen for the delivery of wood shall be 35 cents per cord, ^{for railroad lots of dry} wood delivered in one place and 50 cents per cord for single cords and 50 cents per cord for all greenwood."

By striking out the whole of paragraph four and inserting the following ~~the following~~ paragraph in lieu thereof.

"That the fees to be charged for the delivery of coal shall not be more than 65 cents per ton with an additional charge of 10 cents per load for weighing and that a minimum charge of twenty five cents be fixed for draying only."
