

Special Meeting of the Council of the Town of Carman held Thursday evening Dec. 5th 1918 at 8.30 P.M. Called by the Mayor to consider the matter of arrears of taxes on the Canada Title and Fire Proofing property, due notice having been given those present were Mayor Armstrong Councillors Bridge, Munn, Gardhouse, Eby, Garnett and McGinn. Re arrears of taxes on Canada Title Fire Proofing Plant

McGinn Bridge
That Mr Ogilvie having appeared before the Council asking for certain concessions as to payment of the above taxes it is resolved that the Mayor be instructed to sign upon the advice of the Town Solicitor any or all of three propositions that the Town authorities carry out as follows:

(1) Agreement to allow the issuing of title under Tax Sale application to stand in abeyance for the period of twelve months. Mr Ogilvie agreeing the amount of taxes & costs with interest at the rate of six and one half per cent per annum until paid.

(2) Town to withdraw Tax application and to accept note made by the National Trust Co payable within one year after date with interest at rate of six and one half percent per annum.

(3) Town to withdraw Tax application and accept first mortgage on the property in tax application payable within one year with interest thereon at six and one half percent per annum. Carried.
