That bylaw No 249 a bylaw respecting the sale of milk and cream in Town of Carleton be amended by adding thereto the following clause to be known as subsection "2a": "Every person keeping a cow or cows in the Town of Carleton the milk or cream of which is used for human consumption but who is not a dealer in milk or cream shall obtain a license therefor, and pay a license fee of twenty five cents for each cow; and every such cow shall be submitted to the Tuberculin test applied by the Veterinary Inspector of the Health of Animals Branch, Department of Agriculture, Dominion of Canada - on demand of the Health Officer", and a Bylaw be introduced accordingly and read a first time.
