That the Financial Statement as compiled by the Provincial Municipal Auditor be received and filed. Carried.

That in the event of not hearing from the Department of Public Health within a week that the Secretary be instructed to write the Department of Health urging immediate action with regard to Yut Jack. Carried.

That the Secretary be instructed to reply to Mr C. Garwoods letter stating that as there is no sewer or water main on Maple Ave and that as material is not available at present his request cannot be considered at this time. Carried.

That Bylaw No 607 regarding the sale of properties by the Town of Carman be introduced and read a first time. Carried.

That Bylaw No 607 be read a second time. Carried.

Cochran. Morrison.  
That the rules be suspended and Bylaw No 607 read a third time signed by the Mayor and Secretary-Treasurer sealed with the Corporate seal and finally passed. Carried.

That Bylaw No 608 limiting the hours for the sale of gasoline in the Town of Carman be introduced and read a first time. Carried.

That Bylaw No 608 be read a second time. Carried.

Cochran. Harris.  
That the rules be suspended and bylaw no 608 be read a third time signed by the Mayor and Secretary-Treasurer sealed with the Corporate seal and finally passed. Lost.

That accounts as passed by the Finance Committee amounting to \$1665.62 be paid. Carried.
