A Special Meeting of the Council of the Town of Carman held in the Council Chamber on Wednesday September 10, 1952 at eight o'clock P.M. called by the Mayor for the purpose of discussing street lighting and to receive the Chamber of Commerce delegation regarding improvements By-Law. after having been duly notified all members were present.

It was moved by Councillor Loepky and seconded by Councillor Porter That in the absence of the Secretary, W. S. Armitage act as secretary for the meeting. Carried.

The Chamber of Commerce presented petitions signed by several voters and rate-payers requesting the improvements as outlined in the petition. Considerable discussion followed and questions by the Mayor were asked to clarify certain proposals.

It was moved by Councillor George and seconded by Councillor Loepky that the Council take an immediate vote on Chamber of Commerce By-law. Carried.

Due to a misunderstanding representatives of the Manitoba Power Commission were not in attendance. After considerable discussion the matter of street lighting was left in the hands of the light committee.
