That the Secretary write to the McCabe Grain Company asking them to reconsider their decision to not rebuild an elevator at the present time. Carried.

That We donate \$25.00 to the Red River Valley Development Association. Carried.

That Bylaw No. 809 Re. Borrowing Money be introduced and read a first time. Carried.

Bishop Doyle

That rules be suspended, Bylaw No. 809 be read a second and third time, signed by the Mayor and Secretary-Treasurer, sealed with the Corporate Seal and finally passed. Carried.

Cochran Skelton

That the Kinsmen be allowed parking privileges on Walnut Street from Fournier Ave. to Villiard ave. Carried.

Skelton Doyle

That the building permits of Mrs. Kitching and P. D. Elias be approved. Carried.

Rinn Skelton

That the municipal aid amounting to \$35.00 per month to Mrs. A. Havard be continued. Carried.

Cochran Skelton

That holidays be granted to J. W. Bridge. Oct. 2 to Oct. 10 inclusive. Carried.

Rinn Sprott

That the Council of the Town of Carman are not in favor of their percentage payment on Hospital Deficits being changed and that a letter to that effect be sent to the Hospital Board. Carried.

Doyle Bishop

That the payment of accounts passed by the finance committee and listed in the cash disbursements register be approved and signed by the Mayor. Carried.

Cochran Doyle

That this council do now adjourn. Carried.
