Special Meeting of the Council of the Town of Carman held in the Council Chambers on Tuesday September 13, 1960, 7:30 P.M. Called by Acting/Mayor Skelton for the purpose of dealing with the matter of Business Tax arrears. All members of the Council were present.

1. Doyle - Malcolmson. That Building Permits for H.E. Bennett, C. Johnston and D.S. Shilson be approved. Carried.
2. Malcolmson - Doyle. That By-law No. 873 (a by-law providing for grant to Dufferin Agricultural Society toward cost of arena) be read a second time and vote be taken October 21st 1960. Carried.
3. Boyle - Malcolmson. That the Town of Carman renew its membership in the Provincial Town Planning. Carried.
4. Jensen - Janick. That the secretary-treasurer send a registered letter to all businesses delinquent in business tax, indicating some arrangement must be made with respect to the tax arrears before October 15, 1960. Carried.
5. Jensen - Janick. Effective immediately on water and sewer installation the purchaser of these services pay \$50.00 in advance of construction and the balance payable before the water turned on. Carried.
6. Lucking - Malcolmson. That we do now adjourn. Carried.
