


A

Regular Meeting of the Council of the Town of Carman held in the Council Chambers on Friday, October 14th A.D. 1960 at 7:30 P.M. All members of the Council were present. Mayor Harris presided.

1. Doyle-Malcolmson:- That minutes of regular meeting and special meetings be adopted as read. Carried.
2. Doyle-Skelton:- That applications for Building Permits to the following persons be approved. H.E. Bennett C. Johnston Don S. Shilson G.A. Haacke
Beaver Lumber Mrs. Abbott (Hugh Strong) W.A. Johnston T.A. Johnston
Peterson & Fonger (Carman Collegiate) Ed. Dickinson (to have house rewired)
Bowie Beauty Parlor (add Storm Porch) W. Harness Robt. Wood (by Hugh Strong)
Barney Krohn. Carried.
3. Lucking-Janick:- That By-law No. 874 (to ratify and confirm agreement with R.C.M.P. be read a first time. Carried.
4. Janick-Lucking:- That the rules be suspended and By-law No. 874 be read a second and third time and passed. Carried.
5. Doyle-Malcolmson:- That By-Law No. 875 (agreement between Town of Carman and C.N.R. re drain "agoon to Boyne River) be read a first time. Carried.
6. Malcolmson-Doyle:- That the rules be suspended and By-law No. 875 be read a second and third time and passed. Carried.
7. Jensen-Malcolmson:- That By-law No. 876 (Re Town Planning for 5 years) be read a first time. Carried.
8. Skelton-Janick:- That the rules be suspended and By-law No. 876 be read a second and third time and passed. Carried.
9. Jensen-Doyle:- That By-law No. 877 (Provisions for taking of vote) be read a first time. Carried.
10. Skelton-Janick:- That the rules be suspended and By-law No. 877 be read and second and third time and passed. Carried.
11. Doyle-Jensen:- That wheras it is found that one monthly meeting is not sufficient to complete the work required to be done at such meetings. We therefore have two regular meetings each month on the second and fourth Fridays at 7:30 P.M. Carried.
12. Skelton-Janick:- That we advertise immediately for a Sec.-Treas. for the Town of Carman.. Duties to commence preferrably Dec. 1st but not later than Jan. 1/61. Top salary of \$5500.00 per annum for a qualified officer. Applicant must state age and experience. An invitation is extended to those with partial training in which case, age, experience and salary expected must be stated. Advertisement to appear in local and Winnipeg papers. Applications to be received not later than noon November 9/60. Carried.
13. Doyle-Jensen:- That Council do now adjourn to October 18, 1960. Carried.
