A special meeting called by the Mayor to consider the following matters:-

1. Laycock subdivision
2. Proposed Trailer Manufacturing plant,

was held at 10:30 A.M., Wednesday, August 23, 1967 in the council chamber, Memorial Hall. All members of council were present with the exception of Councillor Lucking who is out of town on vacation. Mayor L.R. Skelton presided.

All members were notified of the meeting and the subject matter either verbally or by telephone. The following motions resulted:

1. Clearwater-Biggar:- The Council of the Town of Carman resolves as follows:

THAT the building lots described in a plan of subdivision of part of the South-West Quarter of Section 30, Township 6, Range 4, West of the Principal Meridian in Manitoba, prepared by Allan Calder Findlay, Manitoba Land Surveyor, and sworn to by him at Winnipeg on the 18th day of August, A.D. 1967 are required for residential building purposes.

Carried.

2. Janick-Bennett:- RESOLVED that plan of subdivision of part of the South-West Quarter of Section 30, Township 6, Range 4, West of the Principal Meridian in Manitoba, prepared by Allan Calder Findlay, Manitoba Land Surveyor, and sworn to by him at Winnipeg, on the 18th day of August A.D. 1967 be and the same is hereby approved for registration.

Carried.

NOTE:- The Secretary-Treasurer was instructed to advise the Municipal Board that according to the Town of Carman's new street designation system, what are designated as College Avenue and Ainslie Street on the plan, should be designated as 3rd Street S.E. and 1st Avenue S.E. respectively, and request that these be changed accordingly.
