Arthur-Hill:- THAT the application of George McGill for a permit to erect a single dwelling residence on the most southerly 20 feet of Lot 31 and all of Lot 32, Block 10, Plan 24, be recommended for approval, providing he obtains and submits to the council of The Town of Carman, a surveyor's certificate indicating that the side yard of the building on the original parcel, namely Lots 29/32, will not be reduced to less than the required five feet.
