

June 5, 1969

The regular meeting of the Carman Town Planning Advisory Commission was held at 7:30 p.m. Thursday, June 5th 1969, in the council chamber, Memorial Hall. All members of the commission were present with the exception of A. T. Biggar. L. Vopnfjord, Municipal Planner, was also present. Chairman B. Sanders presided.

Minutes

1. Hill-Burnett:- THAT the minutes of the last regular meeting be adopted as read.

2. Building Permit, F. Walker
Tefs-Arthur:- THAT it be recommended that the application by Fred Walker for building permit for an addition to the residence on S $\frac{1}{2}$ 11, all 12/13, Block 2, Plan 15, be denied.

3. Building Permit, B. Milne
Shaw-Tefs:- THAT the application for a building permit by Brian Milne for demolition of shed and building new garage on Lots 19/21, Block 10, Plan 24, be recommended for approval.

4. Leave of Absence, Tefs
Arthur-Burnett:- THAT Commission member W. Tefs be and hereby is granted leave of absence from the Carman Town Planning Advisory Commission until September 15, 1969.

5. Down Town Development Plan
Burnett-Arthur:- WHEREAS the Carman Town Planning Commission is presently preparing a Down Town Carman Development Plan as an amendment to The Carman Planning Scheme 1969;

AND WHEREAS many of the features of the Norwich Scheme proposed by Architect Elizabeth Lord under the auspices of the Carman and Community Chamber of Commerce will be incorporated into the Development Plan aforesaid;

AND WHEREAS it is the opinion of the Carman Town Planning Advisory Commission that the initial phases of the Norwich Scheme aforesaid, namely, the painting and decorating of the fronts of the commercial buildings in the area to be effected, should be implemented immediately;

THEREFORE the Carman Town Planning Advisory Commission resolves as follows:
 1. THAT the Carman and Community Chamber of Commerce be urged to take immediate steps toward the implementation of the initial phases of the Norwich Scheme, namely, the painting and decorating of the fronts of the commercial buildings in the area to be effected by the proposed Down Town Carman Development Plan.
