A special meeting of the council of The Town of Carman was held at 8:00 pm., Thursday, October 21, 1971, in the council chamber, Memorial Hall. Present were Mayor S.I. Jensen, and councillors M. Burnett, E.H. Clearwater, H. Isaak, R.S. McKenzie, and F. Lucking. Councillor E. Lansky was absent.

Purpose of the meeting was to discuss the Carman-Dufferin Recreation Commission and the nuisance ground.

Also present at the meeting were the following members of the council of the Rural Municipality of Dufferin: Reeve Lloyd Roth, and councillors R. Findlay, D. Clearwater, M. Dracass, J. Smith, and G. Philippe.


Also present was G.C. Rothwell, secretary-treasurer of the R.M. of Dufferin.

Councillor H. Isaak, who is also chairman of the Recreation Commission, briefly outlined the year's activities thus far. The Commission as at September 30, had a deficit of approximately \$7,113.00, with the deficit centring mainly around the areas of the arena, pool, and park.

The deficit was then discussed in general terms, resulting, finally, in that The Town of Carman council agreed to appropriate an additional \$4,000.00 to the Carman-Dufferin Recreation Commission provided that the R.M. of Dufferin council uphold its half share.

Maintenance, as well as various costs of the nuisance ground were also discussed. It was suggested by the R.M. of Dufferin council that a percentage cost sharing basis be set up. It was agreed by Dufferin council that the matter would be discussed at their next meeting of council, and a report will be presented to the Town Council.

Before adjournment of the meeting, it was decided that quarterly meetings will be held in the future as an aid to better relations and understanding between the two councils.
