WHEREAS the seriousness of Canada's sagging economy, the devaluation of the dollar, extraordinary high interest rates, unbelievably high inflation, the energy problem, the cut in Western Canada's mail service and major strikes have caused a crisis period in Canada and for Canadians, and WHEREAS the individuals and businesses are suffering, and unable to withstand the effects of this crisis till year end, and WHEREAS the Prime Minister of Canada and Finance Minister Honorable Allan McEachen see no necessity for emergency action. THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Municipality of Town of Carman urgently request Prime Minister Pierre Elliott Trudeau for an early recall of Parliament and press the government of Canada to proceed to find solutions to the many serious problems that now confront Canada and the Canadian people.
